
Did You Catch Us At The Welcome Gathering?

We gave each of our staff some time to introduce themselves and talked about how we plan to approach our priority issues over the course of the next 12 months. Our justice work focuses on women's care in four major areas: Women's Health, Women & Work, Women & Poverty, and Stopping Violence Against Women.
